Our mission to provide special dietary food assistance to the elderly and persons with disabilities remains constant, and our distribution methods accommodate persons with mobility impairments. We rely on e-commerce management for pantry and other operations to provide valuable, targeted, and concise services with reliability, autonomy, and dignity for our pantry users.

There is no time limit for using the pantry services or cap on the cost of food received in the packages. However, our services are currently localized to specific communities due to funding.

When registering on the NSS pantry, you can pre-order a food assistance package that will support any of these special dietary needs or concerns:

- low sugar foods for diabetics
- low sodium foods
- low (fat) low cholesterol foods
- lactose-free foods
- vegetarian diets
- vegan diets

Our inventory contains healthy food items, not available from other pantries.

Food insecurity is more significant in older adults aged 65+ and more substantial in the elderly aged 65+ living alone. Family support is essential for successfully aging by elderly members or those with disabilities.

Simple-to-prepare Meal Kits,



Many elderly or persons with disabilities living alone have mobility problems, so they cannot get to grocery stores for food. They need deliveries to their homes or nearby places to quickly pick up a food assistance package.

To meet this growing need, NSS is developing satellite pantry sites in neighborhoods where many individuals need NSS services. Pantry users can place orders at these sites and pick up their preordered packages within a few days or arrange for home deliveries.

If you have time on Thursdays, Fridays, or Saturdays, consider visiting and making grocery deliveries. Most seniors living alone look forward to NSS in-person deliveries.
