During May and June we celebrate the reawakening of our backyard and community gardens. Fresh produce is part of every NSS package or monthly food drive.




When starting your garden this year, plant an extra row of greens, a tomato plant, or a few "hills" of cucumbers or

NSS, Inc. provides **FREE** pantry food deliveries to low-income individuals and their families. Preordered food packages contain only requests because of special dietary requirements and concerns. When registering on the NSS pantry program, Pantry users see a particular shopping list with only items that meet their dietary eligibilities.

Food insecurity is greater in older adults aged 65+ and greater in the elderly aged 65+ living alone. See statistics from USDAbelow:
